Scott has been a Deputy District Attorney in Orange County for the past ten years. He has had a number of assignments including prosecuting all the hate crimes in Scott has been a Deputy District Attorney in Orange County for the past ten years. He has had a number of assignments including prosecuting all the hate crimes in Orange County for over two years and then most recently being assigned to the hard core gang prosecution unit.

He was born in Orange, attended OUSD schools and attended the University of California, Irvine majoring in Political Science. He then received his law degree from UC Hastings College of Law. Scott has been active in the Constitutional Rights Foundation as a Mock Trial Coach. He has taught California Evidence at the Chapman Law School and recently received his Master's Degree in Prosecutorial Science from Chapman.

He has also served on the City of Orange Planning Commission and was its chairman for the past two years.

On June 8th, Scott was elected to the Orange County Superior Court as the youngest (age 36) elected Superior Court Judge in Orange County history. The Orange County Superior Court was established in Orange County in 1889 and currently serves more than 3 million residents. It is the third largest trial court in California and the 5th largest in the nation, with 110 Judges, 33 Commissioners and approximately 1,800 staff. More than 650,000 cases are filed annually. The Superior Court operates seven justice centers in Fullerton, Laguna Hills, Laguna Niguel, Newport Beach, Orange, Santa Ana and Westminster.

Scott is married and has a four year old daughter.
