President 2010—2011**

This week you'll meet our new President, William G. Steiner, known to most of us as Bill. To his FOURTEEN grandkids he is simply known as Grandpa. You'd think that just keeping track of this tribe, ten of whom live in Orange County, would be enough. 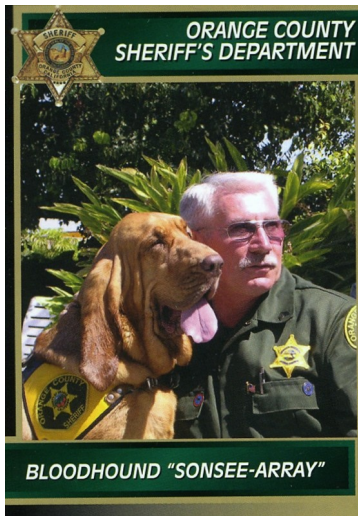

Bloodhound Search and Rescue

Reserve Sergeant Don Hanson

Don became a Reserve Deputy with the Orange County Sheriff's Department in January 1993 along with his first bloodhound Max. In December of 1993 Max passed his qualification trail and a few days later had his first call and saved a missing Alzheimer patient's life. They received the Department's Medal for Life Saving. Together they responded to over 250 calls, but sadly Max passed away April 6, 2001.



Sonsee came to Don November 2003. She passed her qualification train in April 2005 at just 7 months old, making her the youngest bloodhound to ever qualify for the OCS.D. Since then Sonsee and Don have worked calls from missing children to triple homicides. Sonsee trailed a homicide suspect from the crime scene to his home 4 miles away after the homicide, Sonsee has successfully worked 5 homicides, a home invasion robbery that resulted in 5 arrests, and works special events at school.

Since he became a Reserve Deputy working with bloodhounds, Don has averaged over 1,700 hours each year in donated time to the Orange County Sheriff's Department.

Although it sounds like a life of fun and travel, Bill still manages to work full time in his role as consultant on abused children issues, and as well as a Partner in a governmental relations and public affairs company. That's a nice word for lobbyist.

In the realm of volunteer work, in addition to Rotary Bill is the Chairman of the Orange County Juvenile Justice Commission, having been appointed to this position in 2005 by the Superior Court. This commission has oversight responsibility for juvenile hall, Orangewood Children's Home, foster care programs and group homes in addition to reviewing all deaths of children in the probation and child welfare system. He is also a Deacon in his church and Past President of the Community Foundation of Orange.

He has served in elected office for a period of 15 years; five years on the Orange Unified School Board, five years on the Orange City Council and six years on the Orange County Board of Supervisors. Other than politics he says that his most successful accomplishment was working with the private sector to raise more than eight million dollars to build Orangewood in the mid 1980's.

As our new Rotary President Bill is not new to Rotary. He first joined the Corona-Norco Rotary Club in 1967 and then Orange Sunrise until he moved to Arizona in 1999 to work with Merv Griffin to establish a treatment center for abused children. He returned to Orange and joined our club in 2005. We're fortunate to have you with us Bill. You're going to be a terrific President.

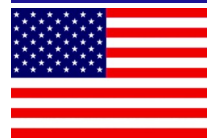
